Penware Parc, Camborne = **Park Penwartha**

The origin of Penware is unclear, possibly a modern construction c.1960. The development area was part of the Penponds tenement in the 1800s with no mention of "Penware".

The translation is based on <-ware> being a variation of *gwartha* 'higher'. Another possible interpretation is the word *gware*, a variation of *gwari* 'to play', in reference to Blaythorne Sports Ground to the north.

Place View Road, St Mawes = **Fordh Gwel Plas**

Saffron Gardens, St Agnes = **Lowarth Safran**

Southview Road, Par = **Fordh Gwel an Soth**

Sunniholme Place, Threemilestone = **Tyller Bos Howlyek**

Trenerry Close, Truro = **Kew Trenerry**

The St Clement TA contains a reference to "Thomas Trenerry", a lessee of the "Bucks Head" tenement. The Trenerry in St Allen may contain the <-i> river suffix.

Witheybrook Lane, Liskeard = **Bownder Dhowr Helyk**

Callington place names

Balston = OBSCURE

Possible interpretations are Cornish <bal> 'mine' and <barr> 'summit'. Otherwise it may feature the Anglo-Saxon name "Beald".

There are numerous references to a 'Balston Down', despite not being recorded on OS maps. The location may be around SX372688. Spellings include "Bellesdone", "Ballesdon", and "Balstondown quarry". The name is referenced as "Ballersdon, alias Balstonhills", in a document dated 1700.

St Dominick place names

Burcombe = OBSCURE

May contain Cornish *berr* 'short' or Saxon *būra* 'peasants'. It is
