	The meaning of this name is obscure.	
	Perranuthnoe	
	Acton Castle = Kastel Acton	
	Browns Tenement = OMITTED	
	Chapel an Grouse = Chapel an Grows	
	Containing <krows> 'cross'.	
	Chiverton = Chi war Tonn	
	Cogreath = DEFERRED	
	Tenement name with most plots around SW547307. Kresen Kernow contains a reference to "Coagreeth or Collygree lode" dated 1784 (Ref: RH/6/5/3/1). There is also the recorded spelling Collagreeth 1801, 1863.	
	The elements are obscure, with <krug> 'barrow' and <kelli> 'grove' suggested.	
	Croft Mason = Kroft Mason	
	It is unclear whether "mason" is the profession or family name.	
	Davey's Tenement = OMITTED	
	Duke's Plot = Pastel an Duk	
	Ednovean = Udhnov Vian	
	From the name Uthno, as found in "Perranuthnoe".	
	Gobellan = Gobellan	
	Containing <go> 'little' <pell> 'far' <-an> 'place of'. Possibly related to the Breton placename <i>Pellan</i> .	
	Goldsithney = Golsydhni	
	Henvor = Henfordh

	Lancashire = Hirkamm	
	Written on the Perranuthnoe tithe map c.1840 as "Lancaster". On plot 852 of the tithe apportionment with the description "Crooked Lane and Lancaster Lane".	
	Also recorded as Lancashire 1825, Lancomshire 1863.	
	Nanturas = Nansturant	
	Containing <turant> 1400, it changed to <terras> by 1557.	
	Owen Veian Common = Kemmyndir Goon Vian	
	Perran Downs = Goon Beran	
	Perranuthnoe = Udhnoweran	
	The meaning of <udhnow> is obscure, but it is likely a personal name. The word order was switched to better represent <udhnow> being the main element. See <i>Udno Peryn</i> c1400.	
	The Gears = An Keryer	
	The settlement of Gears is first recorded as "Gaier juxta Golsidne" in 1570. Thought to be a form of <keryer>.	
	Trenow = Trenow	
	Possibly related to <udhnow> given the proximity.	
	Trebarvah = Trebervedh	
	Trevean = Trevyghan	
	Little Trevean = Trevyghan Lyha	
	Uthnoe Veor = Udhnower	
	East Trevelyan Mine = Hwel Trevelyan Est	
	West Trevelyan Mine = Hwel Trevelyan West	
	Owen Veian Mine = Hwel Goon Vian	
	Wheal Caroline = Hwel Caroline	
	Wheal Charlotte = Hwel Charlotte	
	Wheal Florence = Hwel Florence
