

GROUP ACTIVITY

RESEARCHING CORNISH PLACE NAMES

Recommended for KS2-3 (History, Geography)

Learning objectives

- Use historical enquiry skills to find and research Cornish place names.
- Create a map with the place names found, labelled with both the English and Cornish names.

Time to complete 60 minutes

LEARNING IDEAS

- Divide your class into groups and allocate a Cornish place name to each group.
- Ask each group to research the meaning and history of the name using the suggested sources.
- Have each group record variations of the place name and add photos where appropriate.
- Bring the class back together to present their findings, discuss which sources are most useful.



Some techniques for finding information on Cornish place names:

Tithe maps

Tithe maps were produced to provide information about land ownership and types of cultivation. They are often the earliest maps of parishes.

Maps
